for a pipefitting apprenticeship as prescribed by the 636 JATC

1. Must be 18 years of age or older.
2. Complete this page, the application on page 2-3 and return this form with the following:
 - a. A valid driver's license.
 - b. High School diploma or a high school equivalency (GED) certificate.

3. Upon referral to the Macomb Community College, pay the required testing fee of \$75.00 and successfully complete a written test.
4. Appear for interview when notified.
5. Submit yourself to a background check and substance abuse test, as prescribed by the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.

IF YOU ARE ACCEPTED AS AN APPRENTICE, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO:

1. Attend a 5-week, 200-hour Early Start training program immediately preceding entering the program.
2. Serve a probationary period.
3. Serve a 5-year apprenticeship including the probationary period.
(8,000 hours on-the-job training and 1,200 hours in classroom training).
4. Report for work when required.
5. Have the use of a motor vehicle for transportation to the job site and school.
6. Work under the direction of a Journeyman on the job site and perform job duties satisfactorily.
7. Attend all related training classes and maintain an acceptable average in those classes.
8. Purchase text material for use in related training classes as required and pay quarterly tuition fees.
9. Abide by all rules and regulations of the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.
10. Be physically capable of performing the essential functions of the Apprenticeship Program without posing a direct threat to the health or safety of yourself or others.
